Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a resolution, effective April 1, 2013, adopting an additional five percent (5%) special duty allowance for the PHF Medical Director, Psychiatrist (Class 006167) in the Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health Services Department.

Summary Text:

The County of Santa Barbara operates a Psychiatric Health Facility (PHF) for the care of individuals in need of psychiatric hospitalization. The PHF Medical Director reports to the Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health Services (ADMHS) Medical Director who provides oversight of all medical functions in the Department. In addition to providing leadership in terms of psychiatric services and PHF program development, the PHF Medical Director oversees fiscal, budgetary, and compliance responsibilities for the facility, ensuring compliance with Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) regulatory standards. The duties also include supervision of other Psychiatrists in the PHF unit. The requested Special Duty Allowance will provide additional compensation in consideration of the additional duties and responsibilities.

Background:

The Santa Barbara County PHF is a 16-bed facility that provides 24-hour inpatient care to individuals requiring psychiatric hospitalization. PHF services include psychiatry, clinical psychology, psychiatric nursing, social work, rehabilitation, drug administration, and appropriate food services. The PHF is licensed by the State Department of Health Care Services as a Psychiatric Health Facility. As a

participant in Medicare and Medi-Cal programs, the PHF must meet several specific criteria required by the California Health & Safety Code, including the conditions of participation for hospitals, pursuant to Part 482 of Title 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

In the spring of 2011, in order to conform to CMS requirements, the PHF by-laws were amended to include the creation of the PHF Medical Director position, separate from the ADMHS Medical Director. To meet this requirement, a Psychiatrist position has been filled and the individual is functioning as the PHF Medical Director. A preliminary assessment by the ADMHS consultants supports this action.

The PHF Medical Director will provide leadership of all psychiatric services delivered through the PHF, including overall coordination of patient care, case management, and coordination with hospital facilities. The PHF Medical Director also provides oversight of PHF program development, fiscal, budgetary, and compliance responsibilities for the facility to ensure compliance with state and federal (CMS) regulatory standards and provides direct supervision to other Psychiatrists assigned to the PHF facility.

Currently, positions assigned to the PHF receive a 5% Special Duty Allowance as provided by the Union of American Physicians and Dentist Memorandum of Understanding in recognition of the work environment at the facility. The recommended action will add an additional 5% special duty allowance for this position, in recognition of the increased administrative duties and supervisory responsibilities of the psychiatrist taking the role as the PHF Medical Director. The salary range for a psychiatrist is \$86.68 - \$99.47 hourly. There exists no separate supervisory psychiatrist classification.

Performance Measure:

The recommendation is primarily to ensure adherence to the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) and the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) regulatory requirements regarding supervision and acuity at the PHF facility.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

Budgeted: Yes

Fiscal Analysis:

The estimated cost for remainder of Fiscal Year 12-13 is approximately \$3,378 and the cost is reimbursed from Medi-Cal and Medicare funds, as well as Mental Health Realignment funds. Any additional costs will be offset by salary savings achieved in the PHF program in the first quarter by the under filling of the PHF Medial Director position using temporary Psychiatrists. The additional cost for FY 13-14 is approximately \$14,000.

Staffing Impacts:

Approval of this request will not result in a need for any additional positions as ADMHS is utilizing a Psychiatrist position assigned to the PHF facility.

1. Resolution No. 09-223, adopted by the Board on July 14, 2009, is hereby amended by amending those portions identified below to read as follows, effective April 1, 2013:

Section 6. Specialized Duties

ALLOWANCES – The following allowances shall be paid only upon the written certification by the Department Head to the Human Resources Director of the names of the eligible employees.

a. Employees who are regularly assigned specialized duties, as authorized by the Department Head shall be paid an additional allowance of five percent (5%) of the basic salary assigned to their classification. The number of employees assigned to such specialized duties shall not at any time exceed the number authorized herein:
