I am a homeowner at 5180 Camino Floral in the More Mesa Shores homeowners Association. My wife Carol and I moved here from New York City specifically for exactly the kind of environment that characterizes this neighborhood.

Since moving here we have become aware of how some homes are sub-let/sub-rented through a range of shell games to party planners for commercial/for-profit events that have nothing to do with those who live in the neighborhood. This sort of paper-trail work-around is just that.

These events are noisy, go on for all hours of the night and clog the streets, for which parking is prohibited, with many automobiles. This is a residential, not a commercial neighborhood and should be respected as such.
