

AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH CANNON CORPORATION
FOR THE DESIGN OF NEW SLUDGE DRYING BEDS AND RETURN FLOW SYSTEM AT
THE LAGUNA COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT

THIS AMENDMENT, effective as of the date last written below, is entered into between the Laguna County Sanitation District, a dependent special district of the County of Santa Barbara, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter COUNTY) and CANNON CORPORATION, having its principal place of business at 1040 Southwood Drive, San Luis Obispo, CA 93401 (hereafter CONTRACTOR).

WHEREAS, the parties hereto, on July 10, 2012, entered into an agreement (BC13-030) for performance of professional services by CONTRACTOR in connection with the Laguna County Sanitation District Sludge Drying Beds Project; and

WHEREAS, the original agreement amount for said services was in the not to exceed amount of \$107,382; and

WHEREAS, a proposal for this work has been negotiated with CONTRACTOR and found to be appropriate;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- A. The additional statement of services shown on Exhibit 1, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby, added in its entirety of the aforementioned agreement to accommodate the following:
 - 1. Revised pump station design to accommodate a duplex system.
 - 2. Vacuum truck grit dump station.
 - 3. Placement of additional paving.
 - 4. Preparation of a stormwater pollution prevention plan.
- B. Exhibit 1 of the aforementioned agreement is hereby amended in its entirety by and in the manner to amend the compensation for the above tasks as summarized:
 - 1. Compensation for additional services in the amount of \$5,178 for the items above.
 - 2. CONTRACTOR shall be paid a total contract amount, not to exceed \$112,560.
- C. In all other respects the contract shall remain in full force and effect.







Subject: Laguna County Sanitation District Request for Additional Services

Dear Mr. Wilder:

Through our on-going design efforts, there have been several design features added to the original Sludge Drying Beds scope. These added features are considered necessary to complete a functional sludge bed facility. In the interest of keeping the project moving forward, we are currently finalizing the design utilizing the County's front-end documents and the CSI technical specifications.

The design features that have been added to the original design concept include: 1) a duplex sump pump station for conveying decant liquid to the headworks facilities, 2) grit and vector dump station, 3) addition of asphalt concrete paving, and 4) stormwater pollution prevention plan assistance and drawing with basic BMPs. As a result, the original scope tasks need to be expanded to complete the design. Additional work under each task is described below and a breakdown of cost is attached.

Task 1 – Pump Station Design

Develop duplex sump pump designs with valve vault and vendor controls. Cannon will prepare the design calculations, develop the design drawings, the associated specifications for a duplex sump pump, and assist as needed with direct bidding of the pumps, hatches, and controls.

Task 2 – Grit/Vector Dump Station Design

Develop preliminary drawings for Laguna CSD review and comment. Develop final plans and specifications for the construction of a vector dump station adjacent to the sludge beds. Develop dump station to include a drain inlet structure to all the draining of ongoing collection and storage of collection system materials.

Task 3 – AC Pavement Addition

A recommended design pavement section has been developed and modified. Cost estimates using initial and revised pavement sections have been developed.

Task 4 – Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan

Assist the County staff with preparation of the waiver permit and drawing development for basic best management plans for the Contractor to prevent stormwater pollution.
