




- Encroachment permit
 - Redevelopment Agency pilot process
 - Public Works to issue permit
- Annual renewal
- Revocable by Public Works Director for violations



Annual permit fee

- \$0.75 per gross square foot
- Represents 43% of average lease rate
- Pilot Program fee through December 2010

 \$0.50 per gross square foot
- Public Works Director may update fee annually
 Limited to Consumer Price Index increases



First year

• Approximately \$29,700

Full program

• Approximately \$44,600

Public Works estimated administration cost

• Approximately \$10,000 of revenue
