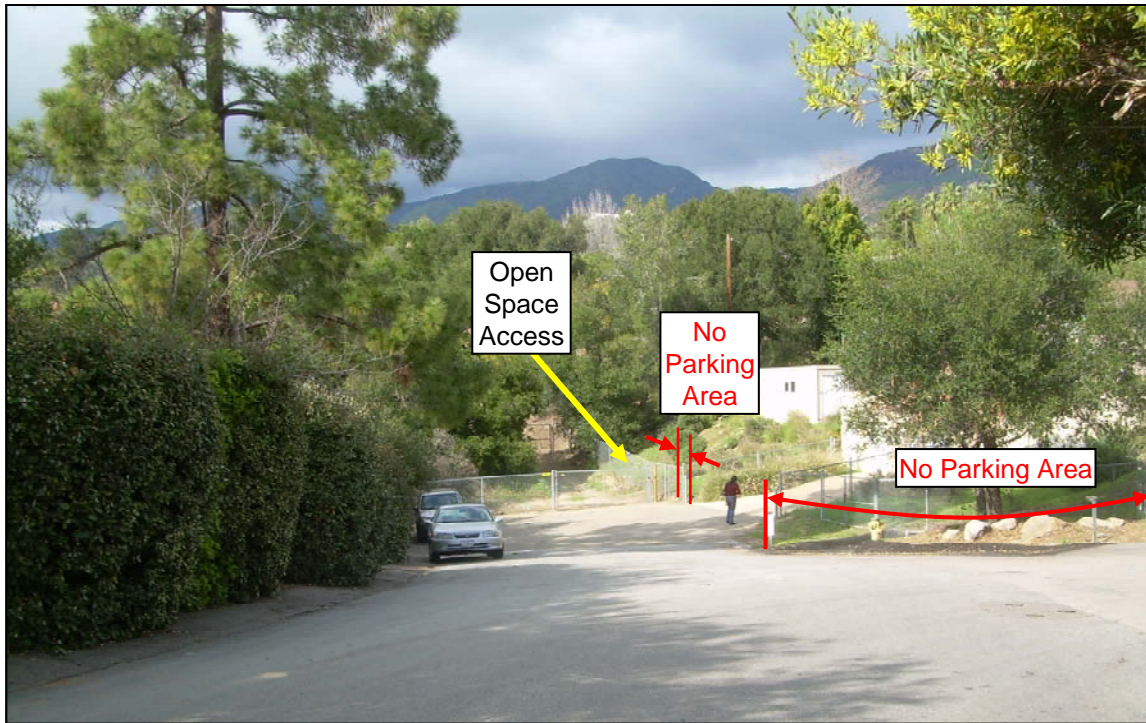
Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Adopt a Resolution for the establishment of a No Parking Zone on Antone Road, Second Supervisorial District;
- B. Approve Notice of Exemptions pursuant to the County's California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines for the establishment of a No Parking Zone on Antone Road, Second Supervisorial District.

Summary Text:

The establishment of new formalized access to the open space at the end of Antone Road has created neighborhood concerns regarding vehicle parking in areas that block access to residences and cause sight distance issues. In response to requests from citizens in the area, The Public Works Department reviewed Antone Road and Debra Drive. Based upon our investigation, the Department has prepared the attached Resolution for the Board's approval, to allow placement of No Parking signs and enforcement of parking restrictions on the east side of Antone Road. Parking restrictions in this area are necessary in order to maintain visibility from the north terminus of Antone Road to Debra Drive, as well as access to a fire hydrant and driveway in this area. Legal parking in designated areas will remain to allow access to the open space.

Background:

Parking restrictions are either established or rescinded based on safety, necessity, and the use by the community as a whole. The Department weighs all of these factors and presents any recommended changes to the Board of Supervisors for approval. These parking restrictions may include no parking, time limited parking, loading zones, vehicle height restricted parking, angle parking, handicapped parking or any combination of these restrictions.

Residents of the subject area initiated the request for no parking zones in the vicinity of the new open space entry gates, due to concerns regarding accessing their properties and safety concerns.
