Authorize the Chair to execute the Agreement to Provide Planning Services Between the County of Santa Barbara and the City of Carpinteria for a period ending on February 16, 2015, on a time-and materials basis.

Summary Text:

The City of Carpinteria has requested the County to continue its provision of energy permitting and planning services, through the Planning & Development Department, Energy Division, for another five years.

Background:

The County has been under contract with the City of Carpinteria to provide energy permitting and planning services since November of 2003. The original contractual agreement was executed for a period of five years with an option to renew the contract in one-year increments. Recently, the Energy Division has provided assistance with the environmental review and permitting of remediating contamination at an abandoned oil/gas site.

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Narrative: Anticipated work is not expected to exceed an average of 0.45 FTE. All costs incurred by the County are fully reimbursable. Revenues and expenditures for Energy Division this fiscal year appear on D-320 of the budget book under Source of Funds Summary-line item Energy Permits and under Use of Funds Summary-line item Permitting and Compliance, respectively.
