RESOLUTION HONORING CASA SERENA AS A 2010 COMMISSION FOR WOMEN SERVICE AWARD RECIPIENT

CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, the mission of Casa Serena is to provide effective treatment services and a safe sober living environment to women seeking recovery from the disease of alcoholism or who are addicted to alcohol and other drugs, to introduce them to the philosophy of Alcoholics Anonymous and the 12-Step process and to promote community awareness of Casa Serena's services; and

WHEREAS, Casa Serena is recognized by the Santa Barbara County Commission for Women as its 2010 First District Service Award Recipient due to the sense of hope, self-esteem, and community it instills in women who are attempting to change their lives; and

WHEREAS, since its inception in 1959, Casa Serena has assisted approximately 10,000 women and currently serves about 85 - 100 women and their children annually; and

WHEREAS, Casa Serena has many programs that are models for recovery, including Graduate House, which provides a bridge of security before individuals return to the community, and Oliver House, where recovering women can live with their children in a safe environment and grow together as a family;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors Casa Serena upon its recognition as a 2010 Commission for Women Service Award Recipient and further commends the Board and Staff for their outstanding contribution to improving the lives of women in Santa Barbara County.
