

## COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA PESOLUTION RECOGNIZING CAN DECOMPTED AT THE OWNER AS THE

RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING MAY 22, 2010 AS THE FIRST ANNUAL HARVEY MILK DAY CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, Harvey Milk was the first openly gay person to be elected to public office in a major city, serving on the San Francisco Board of Supervisors from 1977-1978; and

WHEREAS, the first piece of legislation Milk wrote/sponsored while in office was a non-discrimination bill banning discrimination based on sexual orientation. At the time, it was the most far-reaching non-discrimination law in the country, showing that LGBT representation in elected office is vital to advancing LGBT civil rights and equality; and

WHEREAS, while in office, Milk worked to pass a gay rights ordinance and to defeat Proposition 6, commonly known as the Briggs Initiative, which would have banned gays and lesbians from teaching in public schools; and

WHEREAS, Milk's legacy as a civil rights leader is still felt today. He was named one of TIME Magazine's most influential people of the 20<sup>th</sup> century, and the major motion picture MILK, chronicling the rise and fall of Harvey Milk, has captivated audiences worldwide; and

WHEREAS, Milk encouraged LGBT people to be visible in society and believed that coming out was the only way that they could achieve true social equality; and

WHEREAS, Harvey Milk was concerned that his raised profile as an openly gay man marked him as a target for assassination, and recorded on tape his thoughts: "If a bullet should enter my brain, let that bullet destroy every closet door." Tragically, Milk was assassinated in 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes May 22, 2010 the first annual Harvey Milk Day.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Board of Supervisors of Santa Barbara County, State of California this 18<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2010 by a unanimous vote of all members present.
