Current System

- 32 years old
- Outdated and obsolete
- System support staff retiring
- Software products no longer vendor supported
- IBM (hardware vendor) not familiar with our current equipment

Manatron

- As a result of a (RFI) Request for Information, Manatron was determined to be the best option for the County.
- Manatron system is operating in over 10 states and is currently being implemented in the County of Santa Cruz.
- Manatron has made a multi-year investment to develop a solution to meet the unique requirements of California counties.
- Timeline for project completion: Two Years
