Purpose Behind Key Criteria

1. Project Eligibility

HUD: 24 CFR 570.201-206 CDBG Activity Eligibility

- Must meet one of three national objectives
 - Benefit low and moderate income persons
 - Aid in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight
 - Meet other community development urgent needs
- Must be an eligible activity
 - Infrastructure
 - Housing rehabilitation
 - Economic development
 - Community/public services
- Must implement a Consolidated Plan priority



2. Project Readiness

HUD: 24 CFR 570.902: Timely expenditure of CDBG funds – "1.5 Rule" 24 CFR 92.500 (d): 2 year commit / 5 year expend HOME funds

- Status of entitlements
 - Type needed
 - Timeframe for regulatory approval
- Status of environmental review
 - NEPA and CEQA
- Status of funding
 - Amount committed
 - Outstanding need
- Timeframe for project commencement
 - Less than one year




