**PROJECT TITLE:** Santa Ynez Airport Capital Improvement Project ACIP-23

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION** (attach continuation page, if necessary): The focus of this project is to rehabilitate the aprons and taxilanes that were re-constructed 12-15 years ago (740,000 sf), and Runway 8-26 that was rehabilitated 8 years ago. Rehabilitation strategy will include crack-fill and seal with a focus primarily on paving cold-joints (particularly on the runway), slurry, and pavement markings. There could also be some very localized removal and reconstruction of isolated, failed areas. Work areas have been grouped together into this single project due to the proposed identical pavement rehabilitation strategy throughout.

## **DETERMINATION:**

**NOT A PROJECT** (§15378): A *project* as defined by CEQA is one in which the whole of the action has a potential for resulting in either a direct or indirect physical change in the environment, or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment. ## **FINDINGS TO SUPPORT DETERMINATION:** (attach additional material, if necessary):

The project consists of repair, maintenance, minor improvements and alterations of the existing public structures, facilities and topographical features involving negligible expansion of existing use. The project is categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA pursuant to Sections 15301, subdivisions (a) (minor alterations to existing facilities) of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations, and Section 15302 (replacement and reconstruction). The rehabilitation of the aprons and taxiways is an alteration that involves negligible or no expansion of use. The exceptions to this Categorical Exemption do not apply because there are no mapped resources in the project area, no

cumulative impact, no significant effect due to unusual circumstances, no visible scenic highway, the site is not listed on list compiled to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code, and the airport is not a historical resource.
