## COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION FOR UNDERSHERIFF SOL LINVER UPON HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, Sol Linver will be retiring from County service on Saturday, August 20, 2022, having faithfully served the Sheriff's Office for over 38 years, during which he served as a Sheriff's Deputy, Senior Deputy, Detective, Sergeant, Lieutenant, Commander, Chief Deputy and Undersheriff; and

WHEREAS, Sol Linver started his career with Santa Barbara County on August 14, 1984, as a Sheriff's Deputy. During his thirty-eight years of service, he has worked in various capacities including Corrections, Patrol, Crime Prevention Unit, Training Bureau, Crime Scene Investigator, Field Training Officer, and our agency's first High Technology Crimes Detective; and

WHEREAS, Sol Linver, throughout his career, provided the employees of the Sheriff's Office positive leadership and professionalism, allowing him to rise steadily through the organization, attained the rank of Lieutenant in 2004 and served at the Isla Vista Station for four Halloweens and served as the Lieutenant in the Criminal Investigations Bureau and Special Investigations Bureau; and

WHEREAS, Sol Linver achieved the rank of Commander in 2013 and held assignments in the South County Operations Division and the Operations Support Division and was promoted to Chief Deputy in 2017 and Undersheriff in 2018 and provided the citizens of Santa Barbara County extraordinary professionalism and sensitive law enforcement service while dedicating his life to the pursuit of justice; and

WHEREAS, Sol Linver's knowledge, skills and experience contributed greatly to the overall professionalism and the goals of the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office as well as the objectives of the County, especially during crisis such as the Isla Vista Mass Shooting, multiple vegetation fires, the 1/9 Debris Flow, and the Conception boat fire.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors commends Sol Linver for his faithful and distinguished service to the citizens of Santa Barbara County, congratulates him upon his retirement, and wishes him and his wife, Stephanie, continued good health and many years of happiness.
