WHEREAS, persons with disabilities are a vital and dynamic part of our county, and their contributions have impacted countless lives; and

WHEREAS, through awareness, training and support, persons with disabilities can access opportunities for employment, enabling them to become integrated and contributed citizens of Santa Barbara County; and

WHEREAS, October 2011 has been declared National Disability Employment Awareness Month; and

WHEREAS, this year's theme is "Profit by Investing in Workers with Disabilities."
