RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING
AUGUST 7 - 13, 2022
NATIONAL HEALTH CENTER WEEK
IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, Santa Barbara County is home to five Community Health Centers designated as Federally Qualified Health Care Centers (FQHC), including American Indian Health & Services, Community Health Centers of the Central Coast, Santa Barbara County Public Health Department, Santa Barbara Neighborhood Clinics and the Santa Ynez Tribal Health Clinic, providing high-quality, affordable, comprehensive primary health care in our County's underserved communities; and

WHEREAS, the FQHCs in Santa Barbara County are the health care home for over 108,000 residents. Every day, the Centers provide a wide range of services beyond primary health care, including vision, dental, behavioral health, pharmacy, and other medical specialty services to meet the needs and challenges of county residents. 1 in every 4 county residents gets their care at a FQHC location; and

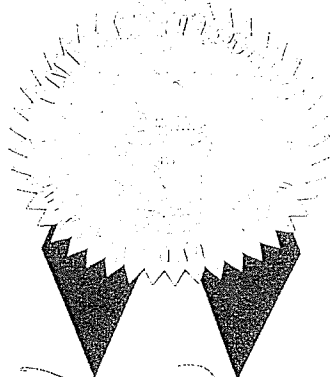
WHEREAS, Community Health Centers' personnel including physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, certified nurse-midwives, nurses, medical assistants and front office staff who work together as multi-disciplinary clinical teams designed to treat the whole patient, are on the front lines of emerging health care crises, providing access to care for our nation's veterans, addressing the opioid epidemic, and responding to public health threats in the wake of natural disasters; and

WHEREAS, the County's Community Health Centers provide essential resources and support in testing and treatment in the face of the ongoing coronavirus pandemic, and will continue to offer reliable, affordable, high-quality care against COVID-19 for America's most vulnerable and underserved communities; and

WHEREAS, National Health Center Week offers the opportunity to celebrate the dedicated staff, board members, patients, and all those responsible for their continued success and growth since the first Community Health Care Centers in Santa Barbara County opened their doors more than 40 years ago.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors does hereby proclaim August 7-13, served as National Health Center Week in Santa Barbara County.
