

The Water Rights Surcharge is a temporary charge to recover expenses related to protecting local water rights and securing a long-term water supply for customers.

Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism/Modified Cost Balancing Account (WRAM/MCBA): Surcharge or credit, ensuring customers only pay CPUC-approved revenue levels, offset by actual water supply costs. It is independently audited every year.

The CPUC approved GSWC's General Rate Case. New rates are effective May 22. Learn more at gswater.com.

California Alternate Rate for Water (CARW) is for low-income customer assistance.

The CPUC fee funds the California Public Utilities Commission, which regulates Golden State Water Company.
