SUBJECT: 2001/2002 Measure 'D' Concrete Repair, Tree Removal, Tree Root Pruning and Shielding, Project No. 820472, Second and Third Supervisorial Districts

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Review and approve the Statement of Final Quantities for work performed and materials supplied for This project by the Contractor, Granite Construction Company (a local vendor), in the amount of \$647,298.45.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No. 1, An Efficient Government Able to Anticipate and Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

This project consisted of repair of the existing hardscape by the removal and replacement of damaged concrete curbs, gutters and sidewalks, installation of federally mandated curb ramps, tree removal, tree root pruning and shielding. Approximately 5,278 linear feet of sidewalk and 4,237 linear feet of curb and gutter was repaired with the construction of this project.

The contract was accepted on July 12, 2002, and was completed on time and within the allotted contract amount.

The project was bid in accordance with the Public Contract Code, which requires the Department to award to the lowest responsible bidder.
