SUBJECT: Resolution to Integrated Waste Management Board for a Grant Applications for the Installation of Playground Cover Utilizing Recycled Waste Tire Materials at Jalama Beach County Park, Fifth Supervisorial District.

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors approve the attached resolution approving a grant application to the California Integrated Waste Management Board for the installation of waste tire playground covering at Jalama Beach County Park.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan: The recommendation is primarily aligned with Goal No. 5.A High Quality of Life for All Residents.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The California Integrated Waste Management Board is currently accepting applications for the installation of playground cover surfacing in public park playgrounds using recycled waste tire materials and to assist public agencies in meeting state and federal accessibility standards relating to public playgrounds. County Parks is proposing to submit an application for approximately \$13,000 for the installation of surfacing for Jalama County Park. This park has been chosen due to its high probability to meet the general guidelines under the grant program. The total project cost is estimated at \$26,075. A match of approximately \$13,075 will be provided (and is required as part of the grant application process) in the form of in-kind labor and a portion of Fiscal Year 2001-02 General Fund Deferred Maintenance Funds allocated to this project.

Mandates and Service Levels: No mandates or impacts to service levels with this action.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts: No fiscal or facilities impacts with this action. Matching funds for this grant are available in County Parks Accumulative Capital Outlay budget.
