I apologize for the delay in responding. We have reviewed your technical report for responses to the requested Actions in the June 1, 2017 Notice of Violation and Technical Report Order.

The County has taken sufficient corrective action related to the Golden Inn & Village development project, such that the site appears to meet the Performance Requirements of Resolution No. R3-2013-0032 (Central Coast PCRs). The plugs in the 4-inch perforated PVC pipe outlets from the detention basins allow for sufficient retention capacity so the site meets Performance Requirement 3 of the PCRs. The updated measurements of storage in the basins, and updated peak runoff calculations for the 2- through 10-yr peak flows, show there is sufficient reduction in peak flows leaving the development site to meet Performance Requirement 4 of the PCRs.

There is additional information that Central Coast Water Board staff requested related to the single family residence cited in Violation 1, and related to the SWPPP for Deficiency 2. The County's responses to this information will be evaluated at a later date.

I appreciate your responsiveness and look forward to reviewing the SWPPP and additional information you plan to provide.
