Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors considers the following:

- a) Appoint Dr. Polly Baldwin, MD, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 101000 as the Interim Health Officer for Santa Barbara County and direct staff to notify the California Department of Public Health of the appointment; and
- b) Determine that the recommended actions do not constitute a "Project" within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), pursuant to Section 15378(b)(5) of the CEQA Guidelines, because the actions consist of the organization and administrative activities of the government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda to appoint Dr. Polly Baldwin, MD, as the Interim Health Officer for Santa Barbara County to replace Dr. Charity Dean, MD, who will vacate the position effective October 27, 2018 and to provide notice to the California Department of Public Health of the appointment. (Health & Safety § 101010.)

Background:

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 101000 "Each board of supervisors shall appoint a health officer who is a county officer." Dr. Baldwin meets the qualifications of Health and Safety Code section 101005 and is a graduate of a medical college of good standing and repute. It is necessary to fill this critical position with an Interim Health Officer until the position is filled.

The Health Officer has a duty to uphold and enforce statutes, regulations, local ordinances, and orders issued by the County or the State. (Health & Safety §§ 101025, 101030; Santa Barbara County Code § 15-130.) The Health Officer also has authority to take measures as may be necessary to prevent the spread of communicable disease or occurrence of additional cases and to declare a local health emergency upon reasonably determining an immediate threat to the public health. (Health & Safety §§ 120175, 101080.) Part-time Deputy Health Officer(s) will support the Interim Health Officer, who also currently serves as the Medical Director for the Public Health Department. It is anticipated that the Health Officer recruitment will take approximately four to six months to select a successful candidate.

Fiscal Analysis:

There is no fiscal impact associated with the appointment of the Interim Health Officer.
