That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve and authorize Contract Change Order No. 3 in the amount of \$487,906.82 for additional sidewalk installation, drainage improvements, irrigation and planting work, hardscape, and street light infrastructure on Lillie Avenue, First Supervisorial District, County Project No. 862256.

Summary Text:

The lowest responsible bid for the original scope of this project was lower than anticipated, due to current high levels of competition for this type of construction project. State funds were allocated to this project were based on the original Engineer's estimate, there is additional money available to increase the scope to include improvements along an additional block in the downtown Summerland area. The amount of funding allocated to this project is a fixed amount. If the funds are not used for this project in downtown Summerland, they will be returned to the State and not be available to the region. The Department recommends approving this Contract Change Order instead of readvertising and bidding this work out to save the costs that would be incurred by the readvertisement and mobilization of another contractor to the site.

The original project limits included Ortega Hill Road and Lillie Avenue between Evans Avenue and Colville Street. Approval of Change Order No. 3 would extend these limits to include work on Lillie Avenue between Colville Street and Valencia Avenue. This change would improve vehicle, bicycle, and pedestrian circulation with construction of curb, gutter, sidewalks, irrigation, lighting, new pavement

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and delineation of bike lanes. This extension would add sidewalk to both the north and south side of Lillie Avenue, as well as improving the intersections of Lillie Avenue with Colville Street and Valencia Avenue.

Approval of this recommendation would increase the contract total by \$487,906.82, for a total amount of \$1,722,900.32. The new total for the contract plus contingency would be \$1,797,150.00.

On November 20, 2007 the Board of Supervisors awarded this project to Lash Construction (a Local Vendor). Because the bid was lower than the original Engineer's Estimate and additional funding was available from the State, funds are available to extend the project limits.
