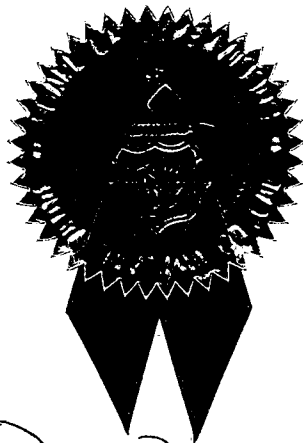
WHEREAS, in war, international conflicts and peacekeeping missions, men and women have been wounded, taken as Prisoners and died in the line of duty; and
