12. Experience: Explain why you are interested in serving and what experience you bring to the Commission.

My interest in early childhood is demonstrated throughout my career. I obtained a Master's in Early Childhood Special Education from the University of Illinois in 1972. My first job was for the state of Idaho where I developed Early Childhood Special Education Programs throughout Region IV – a four county region surrounding Boise. I was made Director of these programs my second year of employment.

I was recruited by Professor Merle Karnes to return to the University of Illinois because she had obtained federal funding to assist agencies throughout the United States to develop Early Childhood Special Education Programs. I worked as national trainer for six years and was made Director of the program the second year.

When federal funding was severely reduced for this project, I was accepted by the University of Illinois to complete a PhD-in-Psychology. I first came to Santa Barbara for the required full year Internship at UCSB Counseling and Career Services. I then did a Post-Doc at Deveraux, where I worked with children and youth who had both learning disabilities and serious behavioral problems. While at Deveraux, I was recruited to be Executive Director of CALM.

During my 18 years at CALM, I facilitated the implementation of multiple evidence-based programs to serve young children including: Home Visitation, Parent Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT), Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Multisystemic Therapy, Incredible Years Parent Education, forensic interviewing for allegations of abuse and others.

I am currently conducting forensic interviews for CWS and Law Enforcement and conduct training on forensic interviewing throughout the county. I serve as expert witness for CWS on child abuse cases.

13. Additional Information:

I gained experience with county-wide issues through membership in several groups including the KIDS Network, the Child Abuse Prevention Council, SART (Sexual Assault Response Team). I was also kept informed of critical issues through CALM's close working relationship with County Departments including DSS, ADMHS, Probation, Public Health, the District Attorney's Office and Law Enforcement.

I continue to believe that investment in early childhood is critical and that the First Five Commission best serves the youngest and most vulnerable. It would be a great honor to continue to serve as a Commissioner as long as I can be of help.

12. EXPERIENCE:

My experience with child development and social services programs in California spans almost twenty years and I believe would bring a wealth of experience to the First 5 Santa Barbara County Commission. In the early 1990s I started working with programs for foster youth, and then have worked for fifteen years in child development, with Child Care Resource and Referral in Sacramento, and then county offices of education in Amador and Santa Barbara. I have administered programs that include child care planning councils, regional resource centers, the CARES, CARES Plus and AB 212 stipend programs to support teachers' professional development, and child care facilities development, including land use policy work through the Constructing Connections project.

I have worked closely with First 5 commissions in Sacramento, Amador and Santa Barbara counties since their inception through the passage of Proposition 10 in 1998. I am currently working as the Program Coordinator for the Santa Barbara County Child Care Planning Council, where I have been employed since September 2011. I have enjoyed a close working relationship with First 5 Santa Barbara during my tenure here on such projects as the STAR Project, capacity building and land use policy work, and various quality initiatives.

During my years in the field of child development, I have assumed many positions of leadership: serving as Co-chair of the California Child Care Coordinators Association (CCCCA), as well as serving on the Executive, Communications, Data and Public Policy committees; I currently am Co-chair of the California Child Development Coalition, a coalition of representatives of several statewide child development organizations; and I am currently the chair of the Public Policy Committee of the California Association for the Education of Young Children (CAEYC), the largest membership organization in the field of early childhood education.

13. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

In addition to the volunteer activities listed above, I have served as a board member for the United Way California Capitol Region, and as a long-time member of the United Way's Education Impact Council, before re-locating to Santa Barbara County. I have also volunteered for the American Cancer Society and for causes supporting foster children. In 2008 I was awarded a Master's in Public Policy and Administration (MPPA) from Sacramento State University, and completed my thesis on land use policy and its affect on child care and development services. Prior to working in my current field, I have had many years of experience in accounting, publishing, media, event planning, and retail management.

As a professional in the field of child development, and as a mother and grandmother, I have an abiding passion for improving opportunities for our youngest children. I believe that I would bring the experience and dedication that would support the important work of the First 5 Santa Barbara County Commission.
