Review and approve the Statement of Final Quantities for work performed and materials supplied for this project by the Contractor, JMA Construction, 9909 Topanga Blvd., #224, Chatsworth, CA 91311, in the amount of \$286,677.69.

**Summary Text:**

The project consisted of placing a county furnished prefabricated steel pedestrian bridge approximately seventy-five feet in length with a minimum clear width of five feet. The structure was placed on a pile foundation, with concrete abutments and wing walls. The pedestrian bridge asphalt concrete approaches which are thirty-five feet long at each end were constructed according to the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

The Contractor removed one native Sycamore tree and non-native and invasive plant species along the creek. The tree removal was mitigated as required per the Mitigated Negative Declaration, approved by your board on October 8, 2002.

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On the Santa Rosa Lane Bridge, a Terminal System (Type SKT) metal beam guard railing was installed; this system provided the required resistance upon vehicular impacts which protects pedestrians from vehicles, if impact were to happen.

The Director of Public Works accepted this project as complete on September 20, 2007. The project was completed on time and under budget.



**Background:**

The Board awarded the contract to JMA Construction to build a permanent pedestrian bridge at Oak Creek on Santa Rosa Lane, located in the road Right of Way (ROW) on the south side of Santa Rosa Lane immediately adjacent to the roadway bridge at the Montecito YMCA.

Authority to award this project was approved by your Board on April 17, 2007, Board File Reference No. 07-00354.

**Measure D** – Measure D-Santa Barbara Transportation Improvement Program. Local ½ cent sales tax passed by the voters of Santa Barbara County November 7, 1989, to be effective April 1, 1990.

The Safe Routes to School (SRTS) will fund 90% of the project with Measure D funding the remaining 10%.

The funds have been budgeted in Dept. 054, Fund 0015, Org. 0001, Program 2900, and Account 7510 (SRTS) and 7511 (Measure D).
