That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the Director of Planning and Development to Issue a Notice to Proceed to Science Applications International Corporation for preparation of the Environmental Impact Report for the Clubhouse Estates Project, Case Number 03TRM-00000-00003 (TM 14,629), located in the Vandenberg Village, along Clubhouse Drive and Burton Mesa Blvd., Third Supervisorial District (APN 097-371-008) for the period of March 9, 2004 to December 31, 2004, in the amount of \$140,603.00 plus a 10% contingency for a total not to exceed \$154.663.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation is primarily aligned with actions required by law and by routine business necessity.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The firm of SAIC is on P&D's list of firms approved by the Board of Supervisors to provide environmental services. SAIC was selected by the project applicant and Planning and Development staff through the Request for Proposal procedures.
