Executive Summary and Discussion:

The Parks, Recreation and Trails Map (PRT-3) for the Santa Barbara area proposes a trail generally following from the end of Northridge Road as a secondary connection to the Arroyo Burro Trail. As part of the January 14, 2005 approval of case 02-LLA-015, Bischof/Odell was conditioned by the Zoning Administrator to offer to dedicate this trail easement across the property to be a segment of the proposed trail connection as indicated on PRT-3. While much of this proposed trail still needs to be acquired by the County to open the trail to public use, this dedication will further the possibility of one day having a trail access to the Arroyo Burro Trail from the Northridge neighborhood. This easement will therefore be held for future use as one of the links for the proposed trail connection.
