efficiency of the Santa Maria Office to today's standards of accessibility, while promoting function and morale.

This Budget adjustment adds appropriations to continue the project this Fiscal Year 2023/2024, namely improving and adding work/office spaces, lockers, a women's locker room, a mother's lounge, new concrete pads for parking spaces, improving the old jail kitchen, and purchasing kitchen appliances, and work

chairs. The project will be funded by the Sheriff AB1600 Fees Fund.

AB1600, also known as the Mitigation Fees Act, provides that Development Impact Fees be enacted and imposed on development projects to mitigate impacts caused by new development projects on existing sheriff facilities. The funds shall be used to acquire, construct and install sheriff facilities or reimburse costs of previously constructed facilities. No funds collected pursuant to this ordinance shall be used for periodic or routine maintenance. Funds may also be used to pay debt service on bonds or similar debt instruments to finance the acquisition, construction and installation of related equipment to the sheriff facilities. Funds may also be used to offset the cost of administration of the fund including audits, yearly accounting and reports, and other costs associated with maintaining the fund.
