WHEREAS, her dedication and effective teaching methods have resulted in 100% of her students passing their citizenship exam; and

WHEREAS, Rosa's journey from undocumented immigrant to proud American citizen exemplifies the transformative power of legal citizenship. Her accomplishments empower both her and others to fully engage in democracy, access education, contribute positively to our nation, and pursue the American dream.
