That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an agreement for regulatory compliance consulting services with Geosyntec Consultants (a local vendor) for the amount not to exceed \$199,630 for a term of July 2, 2019 through June 30, 2020.
- b) Find that the proposed action does not constitute a "Project" within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to 15378(b)(5), organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes to the environment.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda in order to approve the attached professional services contract with Geosyntec Consultants (a local vendor) to provide regulatory compliance consulting services as directed by the County of Santa Barbara Public Works Department. The scope of regulatory compliance and consulting services is for four monitoring and reporting periods each pertaining to groundwater at the Ballard Canyon Closed Landfill, Foxen Canyon Closed Landfill, New Cuyama Closed Landfill, Santa Ynez Airport Closed Landfill, and Tajiguas Landfill. County facilities are subject to compliance with federal and state regulations and approval of the agreement will assist the Resource Recovery and Waste Management Division (RRWMD) in continued compliance with these regulations.

Background:

The RRWMD is responsible for the management and operation of solid waste facilities in Santa Barbara County. The waste management facilities are subject to compliance with state and federal regulations to ensure their safe operation. Approval of the agreement with Geosyntec Consultants, Inc. will assist RRWMD in continued compliance with these regulatory requirements by providing groundwater monitoring, environmental remediation and reporting support for the Ballard Canyon Closed Landfill, Foxen Canyon Closed Landfill, New Cuyama Closed Landfill, Santa Ynez Airport Closed Landfill, and Tajiguas Landfill (Attachment A). Groundwater monitoring, remediation, and reporting support tasks include: the continued database maintenance of software and systems; preparation of groundwater reporting materials and review of groundwater monitoring reports; development of a 3D model to support groundwater monitoring and remediation reports and objectives; remedial systems strategy and evaluation; preparation of a work plan and report to assess per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) for the Tajiguas Landfill; and associated meetings and project management.

Geosyntec Consultants is listed on the Public Works Department's Prequalified Consultant Listing for 2018-2020, approved by your Board at the January 9, 2018 hearing. Geosyntec Consultants has historically provided consulting services to the RRWMD for over 10 years. Geosyntec Consultants has expertise in groundwater, solid waste management regulations, and a detailed knowledge of geological and hydrogeological conditions at the County's waste management facilities. Staff is requesting that the professional services contract with Geosyntec be authorized for continued regulatory compliance consulting services in the amount of \$199,630 with an end date of June 30, 2020.
