RESOLUTION IN APPRECIATION OF LAD HANDELMAN FOR HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO OUR LOCAL MARITIME HISTORY

CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, Lad Handelman was awarded with the NOGI Award by the Academy of Underwater Arts and Sciences (AUAS) in November 2014; and

WHEREAS, Lad arrived in Santa Barbara from New York City in the 1950s and went to work as a tender on abalone boats. He soon joined the elite Black Fleet of abalone boats out of Santa Barbara Harbor, during a period when Santa Barbara supplied two-thirds of the world's abalone; and

WHEREAS, when the oil companies began looking to drill in the Santa Barbara Channel, Handelman joined with several other divers to form CalDive. From their offices on Stearns Wharf, CalDive became the first Santa Barbara based international diving company, and helped put Santa Barbara on the map as the birthplace for deep-water commercial diving; and

WHEREAS, Lad then went on to co-found another international dive company, Oceaneering, again based here in Santa Barbara. Though now based in Houston, Oceaneering continues to be one of the largest commercial diving companies in the world; and

WHEREAS, AUAS is an international, multi-discipline, nonprofit organization dedicated to recognizing pioneers and leaders who have had a global impact on the exploration, enjoyment, safety, and preservation of the underwater world. The NOGI Award is bestowed on exceptional people for their contributions to diving each year.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors congratulates Lad Handelman for receiving the NOGI Award and thanks him for his contributions to our local maritime history.
