Project Background

- SB 35: Qualifying housing development projects reviewed under streamlined provisions
- Adopted into County Code
 - LUDC (January 2023)
 - MLUDC (February 2024)
- SB 423: Implements SB 35 in the Coastal Zone
 - Effective January 1, 2025



Qualifying Housing Streamlined Review

- Applies if County is making insufficient progress toward meeting housing goals
- Certain areas of the Coastal Zone are not eligible:
 - Within 300 ft of beach, mean high tide line, or bluff
 - Between sea and first public road

Qualifying Housing Streamlined Review (cont.)

- Multi-unit or mixed-use projects
- Affordability requirements
- Statutorily exempt from CEQA
- Require ministerial review (CDP)
- Only objective zoning and design standards apply
- Require consultation with Native American Tribes



Policy and Ordinance Consistency

- Implements State laws
- Allows development consistent with existing land use designations
- Projects must be consistent with all applicable objective policies and provisions of the LCP
- Implements Housing Element programs



Environmental Review

- Exempt per Section 15061(b)(3) - no possibility of significant effect
- Exempt per Section 15265 - local coastal program amendments

Next Steps

- Submittal to the California Coastal Commission (CCC) for review and certification

Recommendations

- Make the required findings for approval (Attachment 1)
- Determine that 24ORD-00010 and submittal to the CCC are exempt from CEQA (Attachment 2)
- Adopt 24ORD-00010 adding Qualifying Housing Streamlined Review to the CZO (Attachment 3)
- Adopt a resolution authorizing submittal of the Local Coastal Program amendment to the CCC for review and certification (Attachment 4)
