SUBJECT: Temporary Vehicle Dwelling Parking

First Supervisorial District

Recommendations:

That the Board of Supervisors set a hearing on August 16, 2005 (20 minutes) to:

- a.) Receive an overview on the Safe Parking Program from New Beginnings Counseling Center.
- b.) Consider the introduction (FIRST READING) of an ordinance which amends Chapter 24, Sec. 24-5.3, extending Ordinance No. 4547 for one year to enable vehicle dwelling parking at the County Administration Building parking lot to August 31, 2006 and set a date of September 6, 2005 for the adoption (SECOND READING).
- c.) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the <u>First Amendment To License And Service Agreement</u> between the County and New Beginnings Counseling Center for management of the Program at the County Administration Building parking lot, extending the term for an additional year.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendations are primarily aligned with goals as follows:

Goal No. 2 A Safe and Healthy Community in Which to Live, Work, and Visit.

Goal No. 5.A High Quality of Life for All Residents.

Goal No. 7 A Community that Fosters the Safety and Well-Being of Families and Children.

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Executive Summary and Discussion:

Prior to April 1, 2004, Catholic Charities of Santa Barbara had been operating the Safe Parking Program. The Program enables up to five vehicle dwellings to park overnight in certain parking lots of religious, non-profit, or philanthropic institutions. On November 4, 2003 the Board of Supervisors adopted an ordinance enabling vehicle dwelling parking at the County Administration Building parking lot. The ordinance is set to expire on August 31, 2005.

As of April 1, 2004, Catholic Charities of Santa Barbara turned over all operation and management of the Safe Parking Program to New Beginnings Counseling Center, a Santa Barbara non-profit organization. Gary Linker, Executive Director of New Beginnings will report to the Board the status and progress of the Safe Parking Program at the August 16th hearing. A written version of their report giving a status of the program will also be attached to the Board Letter for that hearing.

On August 17, 2004, the Board of Supervisors directed the County Executive Officer to enter into a License and Service Agreement with New Beginnings Counseling Center for management of the program at the County Administration Building parking lot. That License and Service Agreement is also scheduled to expire on August 31, 2005.

The County Executive Officer has directed General Services to be the liaison for the County with regards to the License and Service Agreement with New Beginnings Counseling Center. General Services is recommending extending the Program for one year from September 1, 2005 to August 31, 2006.

Mandates and Service Levels:

Operation of an emergency vehicle dwelling parking area is not mandated by any local, state or federal law or regulations.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

- 1. The estimate of costs to the County for FY 05/06 to operate the Safe Parking Program in the County Administration Building parking lot is approximately \$2800 annually in addition to administrative oversight costs. There are sufficient funds in the 2005-2006 General Services Department budget to fund these costs.
- 2. New Beginnings has operated the Safe Parking Program since April 2004 and accepts all operating costs of the program except those defined in item # 1 immediately above.

ORDINANCE NO
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE EXPIRATION DATE OF ORDINANCE 4514 WHICH AMENDED CHAPTER 24, OFFENSES MISCELLANEOUS, OF THE COUNTY CODE OF THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA TO AMEND SECTION 24-5.3 SLEEPING OR CAMPING IN CERTAIN AREAS PROHIBITED-GENERALLY-EXCEPTION
The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara ordains as follows:
SECTION 1.
Section 2 of Ordinance 4514 adopted by the Board of Supervisors on November 4, 2003 and amended by Ordinance 4531 on April 27 th 2004 and by Ordinance 4547 on September 7 th , 2004 is hereby amended as follows:
This ordinance shall expire, and Sec. 24-5.3 shall revert to its previous form, on <u>August 31, 2006</u> , unless extended or made permanent by the Board of Supervisors prior to that date.
SECTION 2.
This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from the date of its passage; and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it, or a summary of it, shall be published once, with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the same, in the Santa Barbara News-Press, a newspaper of general circulation in the County of Santa Barbara.
