## **NOTICE OF EXEMPTION**

Based on a preliminary review of the project the following activity is determined to be exempt from further environmental review requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970, as defined in the State and County Guidelines for the implementation of CEQA.

**LOCATION:** Unimproved land on Alisos Avenue, north-west of Lake Cachuma.

PROJECT TITLE: Acceptance of Public Utility Easements by the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION**: The Santa Barbara County Surveyor's Office is reviewing Parcel Map No. 14,568 regarding APNs 141-270-001, -002, -003, -004 and -007 (herein the "Property") which Property is located in the Santa Ynez Valley in the Third Supervisorial District. If recorded the above Map will reconfigure the Property and create three (3) legal parcels out of the five existing Assessor parcels and will grant to the County three twenty foot (20') wide public utility easements to serve the new parcels created by the Map. The acceptance of the utility easement will not be consummated until the subject parcel map is recorded. Prior to recordation the County Surveyor will be satisfied that the subject parcel map is technically correct, conforms to the approved Tentative Parcel Map (or approved alterations thereto), and complies with all applicable laws and regulations.

Further, acceptance of the easement will not create any unusual circumstances which would create a possibility that there would be a significant effect.
