**General Fund Financial Status** 

- ✤ Current Parks Deficit \$275,000.
- Unbudgeted Michael Jackson Trial costs Goal is to contain Sheriff costs under \$2 million.
- Shift, Swap, and Flip revenue adjustments.
- Overall, doing OK after 6 months.



Special Revenue Funds & Other Funds Status

- Roads Storm costs create further budget stress.
- ✤ Fire Fund Property Tax gains.
- Workers Compensation Costs down.
- Liability Significant cost increases; General Fund will feel impact in FY 06-07.

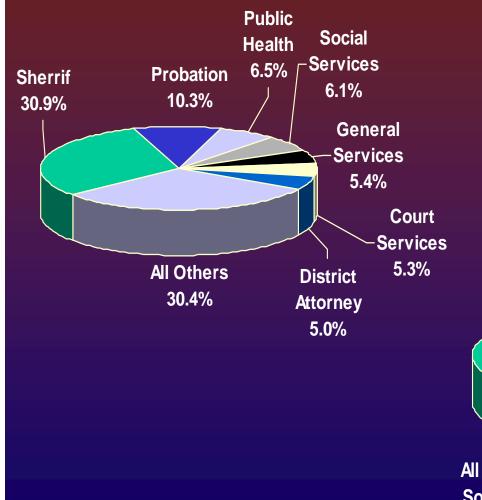
Overall, no negative General Fund impact this fiscal year.



**Discretionary General Fund Revenues** 

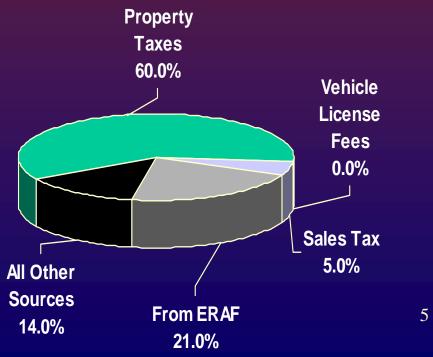
- Backbone of the County Budget See chart: Where the money comes from and where it goes.
- Shift, Swap and Flip Adjustments = -\$4.129 million.
- Current year property tax growth offsets these losses.

Allocation of General Fund Contribution By Department



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Fiscal Year 2005-06 Projection

- Discretionary General Fund revenues up \$9.9 million.
- Most of this money is already committed to COLA's and approved new expenditures.
- Likely that other new initiatives will need to be funded from reductions elsewhere.
- General Fund fund balance of not more than \$3.0 million is forecast for June 30, 2005.



#### Potential Fiscal Year 2005-06 State Budget Impacts

Most impacts in the Governor's Proposed Budget are already included in our FY 05-06 projection.

#### Other Potential Impacts include:

- Medi-Cal Eligibility Revisions
- Decision on IHSS salaries and benefits
- Decision on supplemental Road funding.
