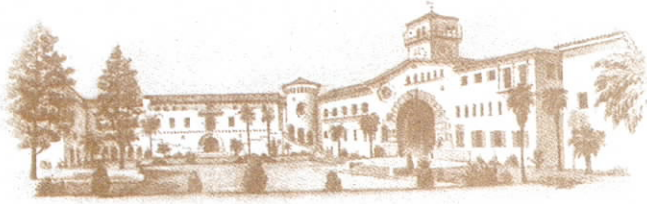

## RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING MAY 2014 TO BE NATIONAL FOSTER CARE MONTH

**WHEREAS**, in Santa Barbara County there are approximately 500 children in foster care who need and deserves a stable home where they are supported and nurtured in a safe environment; and

**WHEREAS**, young people in foster care need the guidance, stability and love that are essential for becoming successful adults from the significant people in their lives while they are in care; and

**WHEREAS**, the enduring and valuable contribution of relatives and foster and adoptive parents who open their hearts, families and homes to vulnerable children and youth play a vital role in helping children and families heal and reconnect; and

**WHEREAS**, there are many individuals, public, and private organizations who work to increase awareness of the contribution of foster parents as well as the needs of children in foster care, and

**WHEREAS**, thanks to these heroes, many formerly abused or neglected children and teens will safely reunify with their parents, or form lifelong permanent connections, and be supported into independent adulthood with relatives, foster and adoptive parents.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara recognizes May 2014 as **NATIONAL FOSTER CARE MONTH**, in recognition of our County's Foster Children and Foster Parents, and all county employees involved in the Juvenile and Dependency System who care for the children and the families that watch over them.
