Recommended Actions:

Consider recommendations regarding a Contractor on Payroll agreement with William Vollero, MD, as follows:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a Contractor on Payroll agreement with William Vollero, MD to provide psychiatric services to clients with mental illness, increasing an existing agreement by \$29,440 for a new contract maximum in the amount of \$54,280 through June 30, 2009.
- b) Authorize the Director of ADMHS to approve amendments to the proposed contract, provided that any such amendments do not exceed ten percent (10%) of the contract's dollar amount.

Summary Text:

William Vollero, MD has been providing temporary psychiatrist coverage for the Santa Maria Crisis and Recovery Emergency Services (CARES North) under a Purchase Order Agreement. CARES North provides mental health services to adults with serious mental illness, including medication support, evaluation, and treatment. Due to the extended absence of a Lompoc Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) psychiatrist, ADMHS requires Dr. Vollero's services at Lompoc ACT. Therefore, it is necessary to extend Dr. Vollero's contract through June 30, 2009, and provide funds for the additional services. As a result of this, Board of Supervisors approval is required. Dr. Vollero will be working 16 hours per week at Lompoc ACT. This contract complies with the County of Santa Barbara Contractor on Payroll Policy.

Background:

The Lompoc ACT program serves adults and older adults with severe mental illness who require intensive services, including 24/7 staff availability. Many of the persons served by the program face co-occurring substance use issues and history or risk of homelessness. The Lompoc ACT services, delivered through a multi-disciplinary team approach, include: medication treatment and support, housing assistance, supported employment and education, peer support, and assistance with daily living tasks.

Dr. Vollero is contracted to provide the following services: psychiatric treatment services at CARES North, Lompoc ACT, and other ADMHS facilities, as directed, including prescribing and administering psychiatric medications as needed, and providing medication education for staff, clients, and families. Dr. Vollero's responsibilities include: intake assessment, diagnosis, treatment planning, and risk assessment.

ADMHS has historically experienced difficulty recruiting and retaining certain key staff, particularly psychiatrists to the area. In previous years, Contractors on Payroll have successfully bridged the gap and helped ADMHS meet the needs of a growing population. Approval of the recommended action will provide needed psychiatry services for the Lompoc ACT through the interim period.

Narrative:

The contract for Dr. Vollero is funded by Realignment, Medi-Cal, and MHSA revenue, identified in the Adopted FY 2008-09 Budget, Federal and State Revenues (page D-160 and D-172 in the FY 2008-09 County Budget Book, in the Adult Mental Health Services Division and the MHSA Division, respectively). Execution of this contract will not increase the use of general fund dollars by the ADMHS

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Department. The increase to Dr. Vollero's contract is being funded from salary savings from the psychiatrist on extended leave.
