WHEREAS, the California Arts Council and the California State Legislature have established a State Local Partnership Program (SLPP) designed to encourage local cultural planning and programming; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara designates the Santa Barbara County Office of Arts and Culture as the County's partner in the State-Local Partnership Program and approves and authorizes the Santa Barbara County Office of Arts and Culture to submit grant proposals and to execute the grant contracts if awarded.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SANTA BARBARA COUNTY as follows:

1. The Santa Barbara County Office of Arts and Culture is approved and authorized to submit an application for a fiscal year 2016-17 SLPP grant to the California Arts Council; and
2. The Santa Barbara County Office of Arts and Culture is approved and authorized to execute a grant agreement for the fiscal year 2016-2017 SLPP Grant if awarded by the California Arts Council.
