WHEREAS, Jeffrey & Carole Bloom moved to Los Alamos in 2012, settling in to enjoy its quiet, small town charm after decades of living in Los Angeles;

WHEREAS, while in Los Angeles, Jeffrey was a screenwriter, director, photographer, and producer in Hollywood, making features and television movies, but also wrote screenplays, theatrical plays, stories, poems, and even a book or two;

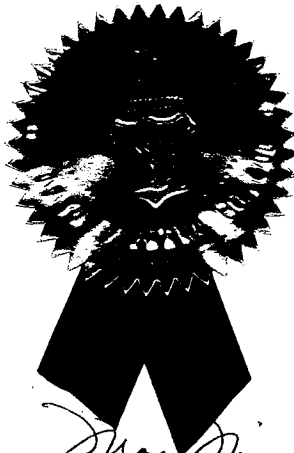
