Public Health

The funds will be spent to meet the requirements of the Federal/State BT Program and build upon the foundation laid last year. Basically, these funds were already budgeted, but we received enhance funding. No new positions are planned beyond the 2.5 that were added last year. The increased funds will be spend on required upgrades to our Public Health Lab systems (the fixed asset purchases), planning for the Strategic National Stock pile (SNS) of pharmeuticals, and for post-event small pox vaccinations.
