**SUBJECT:** Public Hearing to Accept Donated Funds From Sheriff's Council

**Recommendation(s):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

To accept the donation of \$1,014,997 in donated funds from the Santa Barbara Sheriff's Council to be used for the purchase of equipment.

**Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:**

This recommendation is primarily aligned with Goal No. 2. A Safe and Healthy Community in Which to Live, Work, and Visit.

**Executive Summary and Discussion:**

The Santa Barbara Sheriff's Council is a California Non-Profit Public Benefit Corporation. It is organized under the Non-Profit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

A purpose of the Santa Barbara Sheriff's Council is to raise funds and accept monetary, equipment, and in kind donations, in any lawful manner; and to use funds available to the Council for the purchase of materials and equipment for use by the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Department.

The Santa Barbara Sheriff's Council has committed to donate funds for the purchase of the following items:
