The Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing to discuss connecting Stubblefield Road to Black Oak Drive, located in south east Orcutt. The hearing will be held on **Tuesday, January 10, 2006 in Santa Maria** at the Betteravia Government Center, Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 511 E. Lakeside Parkway.

At the hearing the Board of Supervisors will

- 1) Receive a report on the feasibility and design options to connect Stubblefield Road to Black Oak Drive, including traffic calming features.
- 2) Consider directing Comprehensive Planning Division staff, in coordination with Public Works staff, to prepare an Orcutt Community Plan (OCP) amendment, including environmental review document, to amend the Circulation element for connection of Stubblefield Road.
- 3) Consider funding the Stubblefield/Black Oak Connection project in the amount of \$242,000.

The Board of Supervisors hearing begins at 9:00 a.m. Anyone interested in this matter is invited to appear and speak in support of or in opposition to the project. Written comments are also welcome.
