#### **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors:

Consider Case No. 08AGP-00000-00008 for approval of one prime agricultural preserve replacement contract for Randy Campbell.

The Board of Supervisors action should include the following:

A. Approve and direct execution and recordation by the Clerk of the Board of new contract 08AGP-00000-00008, replacing a portion of the original Agricultural Preserve 70-AP-114. The replacement contract involves Assessor's Parcel number 099-170-053, located approximately 1,200 feet northeast of the intersection of Highway 246 and Campbell Road, in the Lompoc area, Fourth Supervisorial District.

## **Summary Text:**

The subject property has been in an agricultural preserve (70-AP-114) since January 1, 1971. The original preserve was approximately 866.5 acres and was comprised of seven parcels. The replacement contract is being requested due to a change in ownership. The replacement contract is approximately 55.5 acres. One hundred percent of the original contract would be placed back into the Agricultural Preserve Program. The parcel is currently used for cattle grazing and crops.

#### **Background:**

Government Code §51200 (known as the California Land Conservation Act of 1965 or the Williamson Act) provides that local jurisdictions may establish an agricultural preserve program having the goal of retaining land in an agricultural use. The County of Santa Barbara has adopted such a program which is codified under the Agricultural Preserve Program Uniform Rules. Both the County's Uniform Rules and the Government Code provide that agricultural preserve contracts between the County and landowners are voluntary. Therefore, there are no state mandates associated with this program.

### **Fiscal Analysis:**

There are no fees associated with replacement contracts. The cost for the contract review and preparation of this report is estimated to be \$1000.00, and is budgeted in the Permitting & Compliance Program of the Development Review, North Division on Page D-305 of the adopted 2008–2009 fiscal year budget.
