In terms of local action, I served in my student government in a community college, and I currently work with ASCSM. Additionally, I did quite a bit of work with local and statewide campaigns over the past three years, much of it with my local Democratic party back in the Bay Area. This led me to develop experience related to policy and legislative analysis, as well as the communication skills to properly connect those policies to the greater community. Speaking of legislative analysis and policy formation, the three boards which I'm applying speak to the three primary concerns of mine in terms of local policy in Santa Barbara. There's a huge housing crisis affecting both UCSB students and the greater Santa Barbara community, and my hope is that working on the Housing Authority Board will allow me to advocate for sustainable development on and around the Santa Barbara county coast. Basic needs are critical to ensuring a safe community, and I want to work within the county to advocate for better access by working on the Human Services Commission. Finally, as someone who lives in public housing in Isla Vista, the safety and security of that community are very near and dear to my heart and to my everyday life. My work within the AS of UCSB and my life in Isla Vista makes me a stakeholder in that community, and I'd want to lend my voice to the IVCS as a stakeholder.
