- C. Authorize the Chair to execute the construction contract upon return of the Contractor's executed contract documents, the review and approval of the County Counsel, Auditor-Controller, Risk Manager or their authorized representative;
- D. Approve a contingency fund in the amount of \$30,477.32 for Construction of 2008/09 Zaca Fire Repair on Santa Barbara Canyon Road in the 5th Supervisorial District of Santa Barbara County, Project No. 810533.

Summary Text:

On Thursday, August 14th, 2008, seven (7) bids were opened for the Construction of 2008/09 Zaca Fire Repair on Santa Barbara Canyon Road in the 5th Supervisorial District of Santa Barbara County, Project No. 810533. The lowest responsive bid was submitted by Union Asphalt, Inc. (a local vendor), a California Corporation, in the amount of \$ 359,546.40. This amount is 13.3% under the Engineer's Estimate. Public Works staff has performed analysis of the bid received and has determined that the bid is responsive and reasonable and recommends awarding this contract to Union Asphalt, Inc.

The proposed project is located on Santa Barbara Canyon Road in the unincorporated area of Cuyama in the County of Santa Barbara. It includes overlaying a total of 3.0 miles of the road, from Foot Hill Road to South End, using a Type B asphalt concrete.

This project was bid in accordance with the Public Contract Code, which requires awarding to the lowest responsive bidder.

Background: On July 4th 2007, the Zaca Fire started north of Los Olivos and east of Foxen Canyon Road. By August 3rd, the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors declared a local emergency in response to the changing situation of the Zaca Fire and also activated its Emergency Operation Center. Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger visited the County's Emergency Operation Center on the same date and signed a state declaration of emergency for the Zaca Fire. By the time it was fully contained on September 4, 2007, the Zaca Fire had burned approximately 240,207 acres.

During the 60 days of fire control efforts and subsequent demobilization and clean up, Santa Barbara Canyon Road sustained significant road damage. This road was used as a primary entry point into the Los Padres National Forest and out of the Richardson Camp in New Cuyama. Traffic included transportation of heavy equipment, bulldozers, water trucks, fire engines and personnel around the clock. Santa Barbara Canyon Road is also the only access to many residents at the south end of the road.

This project allows for rehabilitation of Santa Barbara Canyon Road utilizing State Office of Emergency Services (OES) funds in combination with a match from local Measure D funds.
