RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

IN THE MATTER OF ADOPTING)
THE STREETScape CONCEPT) RESOLUTION NO. 06-
PLAN FOR OLD TOWN ORCUTT)

WITH REFERENCE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- A. On December 20, 1980, by Resolution No. 80-566, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Land Use Element of the Santa Barbara County Comprehensive Plan; and
- B. On January 3, 1983, by Ordinance 3347, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Santa Barbara County Inland Zoning Ordinance, Article III of Chapter 35 of the Santa Barbara County Code; and
- C. On July 22, 1997, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Orcutt Community Plan update to the Santa Barbara County Comprehensive Plan.
- D. On June 17, 2005, the Board of Supervisors directed Comprehensive Planning staff to develop a draft Streetscape Concept Plan for Old Town Orcutt.
- E. From July 2005 to June 2006, County staff has been working collaboratively with the Public Works Department and the 4th District Office and has also conducted individual meetings with representatives of three community organizations: Residents for Old Town Orcutt Preservation (ROTOP), Orcutt Area Advisory Group (OAAG), and the Old Town Orcutt Revitalization Association (OTORA). Two public workshops were held to develop the draft Streetscape Concept Plan. The draft plan was also reviewed by the North County BAR.

- F. It is now deemed to be in the interest of orderly development of the County and important to the preservation of the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of the County that the Board of Supervisors adopt the Old Town Orcutt Streetscape Concept Plan as shown in Exhibit B.
- G. Public officials and agencies, civic organizations, and citizens have been consulted and have advised the Planning Commission and Board of Supervisors on said proposed guidelines in public hearings, and the Planning Commission has sent its written recommendations to the Board.
- H. This Board has held a duly noticed public hearing on the proposed guidelines, at which hearing the guidelines were explained and comments invited from the persons in attendance.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

1. The above recitations are true and correct.
2. The Old Town Orcutt Streetscape Concept Plan is hereby adopted.
