SUBJECT: **No Parking Zone on East Valley Road (Highway 192); First Supervisorial District.**

RECOMMENDATIONS:

C.A. Recommendation: _____

That the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution establishing a "No Parking" zone on East Valley Road in the Montecito area.

ALIGNMENT WITH BOARD STRATEGIC PLAN:

The recommendation is primarily aligned with Goal #2: Ensure the public health and safety and provide essential infrastructure.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY & DISCUSSION:

East Valley Road is a two lane major east-west arterial road paralleling the U.S. 101, in the Montecito area.

A number of complaints have been received requesting that a "No Parking" zone be established on the north side of East Valley Road (Highway 192), at its intersection with Romero Canyon Road to help improve sight distance for motorists. Based upon our investigation of this site, it was determined that creating a "No Parking" zone at this location (see vicinity map) would increase sight distance and improve public safety for those residing and traveling on Romero Canyon Road as well as East Valley Road. The Public Works Traffic Section is currently coordinating with Caltrans on making this area safer for the public. Caltrans has indicated that they would support the County's restriction of parking at this location. The attached resolution to establish a "No Parking" zone at the following location:

On the north side of East Valley Road from the centerline of Romero Canyon Road, to a point 145 feet east of the centerline of Romero Canyon Road.
