### **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Directors of the Santa Barbara County Flood Control and Water Conservation District Accept a <u>Permanent Easement</u> from Charles and Tawny Crail, owner of Santa Barbara County Assessor parcel number 007-340-054, by authorizing the Clerk of the Board to sign the Certificate of Acceptance attached thereto.

#### **Summary Text:**

If the easement is accepted by the Board it will provide Flood Control with access to San Ysidro Creek upstream of Bridge number 51C-342 on North Jameson Lane in Montecito. Flood Control crews maintain the creek during and after storms to remove rocks and organic matter (tree limbs, etc.) which may impede water flow thus endangering the public and infrastructure like the bridge.

### **Background:**

Historically Santa Barbara County Flood Control crews have accessed the subject portion of San Ysidro Creek via an easement granted to them in 1977. As part of the North Jameson Lane realignment and improvement project the railings on Bridge number 51C-342 was lengthened and cut off the 1977 access route. The easement in question will reestablish access to the creek and will consummate the right of way portion of a legal settlement agreed to by the County and the Montecito Avocado Ranch on May 27, 2004.
