SUBJECT: Set Hearing to Consider Response to the Grand Jury Report entitled "Law, Justice

and Public Safety: Health Care within Detention Facilities"

### **Recommended Actions:** That the Board of Supervisors:

A. Set a hearing on the departmental agenda for July 10, 2007 to discuss and consider the Board of Supervisors' responses to the 2006-2007 Grand Jury Report entitled "Law, Justice and Public Safety: Health Care within Detention Facilities."

#### **Summary Text:**

On May 7, 2007, the Civil Grand Jury released a report entitled "Law, Justice and Public Safety: Health Care within Detention Facilities." The focus of this report is health issues among the inmate population and grievance and release procedures. The report includes nine findings and six recommendations. The Board of Supervisors is named as a responder to all of the findings and recommendations in addition to the Sheriff's Department, Alcohol Drug and Mental Health Services, and County Executive Office. The response to the Grand Jury report is currently being prepared and will be presented as part of the July 10, 2007, Board Hearing.

### **Background:**

Per California Penal Code Section 933 (b), the governing body of the agency, the Board of Supervisors, must respond within 90 days after the issuance of the Grand Jury Report. Therefore, the Board of Supervisors' response must be finalized and transmitted to the Courts and the Grand Jury no later than August 7, 2007.
