RESOLUTION HONORING AARON ETTENBERG FOR THE 2010 ANTI-DEFAMATION LEAGUE DISTINGUISHED COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

WHEREAS, Aaron Ettenberg has been named as a recipient of the Anti-Defamation League 2010 Distinguished Community Service Award; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ettenberg earned his doctoral degree in Psychopharmacology from McGill University in 1980. Mr. Ettenberg is a leading authority on the neurobiology of substance abuse, and is a Distinguished Fellow of both the American Psychological Association and the American Psychological Society; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ettenberg has been awarded two of UCSB's highest faculty honors—the Harold J. Plous Memorial Award and the Distinguished Faculty Teaching Award; and

WHEREAS, in the Jewish community, Mr. Ettenberg worked for several years on the Board of Trustees of Santa Barbara's Jewish Federation and received that organization's "Outstanding Young Leadership" award in 1993; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ettenberg is currently the faculty advisor for UCSB Hillel and is currently in his 25th year on the Congregation B'nai B'rith board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, for over 20 years Mr. Ettenberg has made monthly visits to CBB's preschool, Beit Hayeladim, to sing with the youngest members of the congregation. Most of his volunteer efforts have been at Congretation B'nai B'rith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors and commends Aaron Ettenberg for his outstanding contributions to our community and for being a recipient of the 2010 Anti-Defamation League Distinguished Community Service Award.
