WHEREAS, Smiley Wilkins continued his impressive service to the community when he became President of the NAACP Santa Maria-Lompoc Branch in 1984 and served for a generous 23 years; and

WHEREAS, Smiley Wilkins Sr. passed away on September 10, 2007, leaving behind a legacy of activism and community involvement and is survived by his wife Nannie Wilkins of 56 years, daughter Gwendolyn Talifero, and two sons Smiley Wilkins Jr. and Marcus Wilkins;
