WHEREAS, Carlos Balderas, born and raised in Santa Maria, California represented the United States of America in the 2016 Olympics held in Rio de Janeiro Brazil; and

WHEREAS, Carlos first visited a boxing gym as a punishment for street fighting with his friends, but soon found that he loved the sport and wanted to someday participate in the Olympics; and

WHEREAS, Carlos is coached by his father Xenon and Uncle David Balderas; and

WHEREAS, Carlos qualified for the Men's Lightweight Boxing event at the 2016 Summer Olympics after participating in the World Series of Boxing where he won the Gold Medal in his elite division and was named Outstanding Boxer of the event; and

WHEREAS, Carlos boxed his way to the Quarter Finals at the 2016 Summer Olympics, having won his first two bouts in the Men's Light 60 kg, his third bout was met with determination and skill against the 2012 Bronze Medalist Lazaro Alvarez of Cuba; and
